Consultation on the future of St Aloysius Catholic Primary School



The school's governing body is consulting on closing the school due to falling birth rates, lower numbers of school-age children in the area, and a drop in pupil numbers at the school.

Around 1 in 5 primary school places in the south/central area of Camden were unfilled in 2017/18. (19.2%)

At St Aloysius in 2017/18, only around half the expected number of pupils joined the school: 32 pupils out of 60. 47% of places were unfilled.

The number of school-age children living locally is not expected to increase before 2027.
